## **Overview**

- Advising on quantum in a claim involving negligent performance of decompression of the ulnar nerve.
- Advising on quantum in a claim involving a failure to administer intrapartum antibiotics.
- Advising in relation to non-delegable duties owed by a NHS Trust.
- Acting in relation to a claim involving the development of an infection leading to an above knee amputation.
- Achieving settlement, at a joint settlement meeting, of a claim for negligent performance of knee replacement surgery.
